Year 2 in Review

GE volunteers spent **5,689 hours** supporting Next Engineers students, providing mentorship, taking students on GE facility tours, and offering feedback on their design projects.



Total Number of Unique Students Reached: **6,841**

Engineering Discovery engaged students **over 9,000** times in hands-on activities, raising interest and awareness of engineering.

ENGINEERING CAMP

Engineering Camp hosted **765 students**



65% of whom were from underrepresented populations in immersive, week-long experiences in which students toured university campuses, worked in teams to complete design projects, and spoke with academic and professional engineers about their career pathways.
